A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SEC'I	ION 1. Chapter 302A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to re	ad as follows:
4	" <u>§30</u>	2A- Automated external defibrillators; requirements;
5	training.	(a) By the end of the 2017-2018 school year:
6	(1)	All public schools shall have an automated external
7		defibrillator situated in a permanent location on
8		campus;
9	(2)	All public schools that have an athletic trainer shall
10		ensure that at every sporting event, an additional
11		automated external defibrillator is available and the
12		athletic trainer is trained and certified at all times
13		in the use of automated external defibrillators; and
14	(3)	All public schools that do not have an athletic
15		trainer shall ensure that at every sporting event, at
16	•	least two faculty members of the school are trained

1		and certified at all times in the use of automated
2		external defibrillators.
3	(b)	The department shall ensure that the automated
4	external	defibrillator is:
5	(1)	Maintained and regularly tested according to the
6		operation and maintenance guidelines set forth by the
7		manufacturer; and
8	(2)	Checked for readiness after each use and at least once
9		every thirty days if the automated external
10		defibrillator has not been used in the preceding
11		thirty days; provided that records of the checks shall
12		be maintained by the department and the individual
13		school.
14	(c)	For purposes of this section, "sporting event"
15	includes	competitions, scrimmages, and practices."
16	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 302D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended b	y adding a new section to be appropriately designated
18	and to re	ad as follows:
19	" <u>§30</u>	2D- Automated external defibrillators; requirements;
20	training.	(a) By the end of the 2017-2018 school year:

1	(1)	All charter schools shall have an automated external
2		defibrillator situated in a permanent location at the
3		charter school;
4	(2)	All charter schools that have an athletic trainer
5		shall ensure that at every sporting event, an
6		additional automated external defibrillator is
7		available and the athletic trainer is trained and
8		certified at all times in the use of automated
9		external defibrillators; and
10	(3)	All charter schools that do not have an athletic
11		trainer shall ensure that at every sporting event, at
12		least two faculty members of the charter school are
13		trained and certified at all times in the use of
14		automated external defibrillators.
15	(b)	Each charter school shall ensure that the automated
16	external o	defibrillator is:
17	(1)	Maintained and regularly tested according to the
18		operation and maintenance guidelines set forth by the
19		manufacturer; and
20	(2)	Checked for readiness after each use and at least once
21		every thirty days if the automated external

1		defibrillator has not been used in the preceding
2		thirty days; provided that records of the checks shall
3		be maintained by the charter school.
4	(c)	For purposes of this section, "sporting event"
5	includes c	competitions, scrimmages, and practices."
6	SECTI	ON 3. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
7	amended by	adding a new section to be appropriately designated
8	and to rea	d as follows:
9	" <u>§</u> 304	A- Automated external defibrillators; requirements;
10	training.	(a) By the end of the 2017-2018 school year:
11	(1)	All divisions and campuses of the University of Hawaii
12		system shall have an automated external defibrillator
13		situated in a permanent location on campus; and
14	(2)	The athletic department of the University of Hawaii,
15		with regard to each institution under the University
16		of Hawaii system, shall ensure that:
17		(A) There is an automated external defibrillator
18		available to the athletic trainer present at
19		every sporting event; and

1		(B) Every athletic trainer is trained and certified
2		at all times in the use of automated external
3		defibrillators.
4	(b)	The University of Hawaii and each institution under
5	the Unive	rsity of Hawaii system shall ensure that the automated
6	external	defibrillator is:
7	(1)	Maintained and regularly tested according to the
8		operation and maintenance guidelines set forth by the
9		manufacturer; and
10	(2)	Checked for readiness after each use and at least once
11		every thirty days if the automated external
12		defibrillator has not been used in the preceding
13		thirty days; provided that records of the checks shall
14		be maintained by the University of Hawaii.
15	(c)	For purposes of this section, "sporting event"
16	includes	competitions, scrimmages, and practices."
17	SECT	ION 4. Section 663-1.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
18	amended b	y amending subsection (e) to read as follows:
19	"(e)	Any person who in good faith, without remuneration or
20	expectati	on of remuneration, attempts to resuscitate a person in
21	immediate	danger of loss of life when administering any

- 2 automated external defibrillator that is used is located, shall
- 3 not be liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or
- 4 omission except as may result from the person's gross negligence
- 5 or wanton acts or omissions[-]; provided that an athletic
- 6 trainer or faculty member who administers an automated external
- 7 defibrillator pursuant to section 302A- , 302D- , or 304A- ,
- 8 shall be considered to be doing so in good faith, without
- 9 remuneration or expectation of remuneration.
- 10 Any person, including an employer, who provides for an
- 11 automated external defibrillator or an automated external
- 12 defibrillator training program shall not be vicariously liable
- 13 for any civil damages resulting from any act or omission of the
- 14 persons or employees who, in good faith and without remuneration
- 15 or the expectation of remuneration, attempt to resuscitate a
- 16 person in immediate danger of loss of life by administering an
- 17 automated external defibrillator, except as may result from a
- 18 person's or employer's gross negligence or wanton acts or
- 19 omissions."
- 20 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

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Report Title:

Education; Automated External Defibrillators

Description:

Requires by the end of the 2017-2018 school year, that all public schools, public charter schools, and the University of Hawaii and its divisions, campuses, and institutions have automated external defibrillators situated in a permanent location on campus. Requires the University of Hawaii and public and charter schools that have an athletic trainer to have an automated external defibrillator available at each sporting event. Requires the automated external defibrillators to be maintained and tested regularly. Clarifies that an athletic trainer or faculty member who administers an automated external defibrillator shall be considered to be doing so without remuneration or expectation of remuneration for purposes of immunity from civil liability.
