A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESS INDIVIDUALS WITH SEVERE MENTAL ILLNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State has a gap 2 in services for homeless individuals with severe mental illness,
- 3 as these individuals often cycle between homelessness, emergency
- 4 room treatment, incarceration, and hospitalization. Individuals
- 5 with severe mental illness typically become chronically homeless
- 6 and further burden the health care system through excessive use
- 7 of expensive emergency services, inpatient treatment, and crisis
- 8 services. The legislature further finds that homeless
- 9 individuals with severe mental illness who are discharged from
- 10 acute care often need services and shelter to assist in
- 11 transitioning back to healthy and successful lives.
- 12 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 13 human services, in consultation with the department of health,
- 14 to issue a request for proposal to contract for services and
- 15 housing for homeless individuals with severe mental illness who
- 16 are discharged from acute care and require further medical
- 17 treatment and other supportive services.

1	SECTION 2.	(a) Pursuant	to	chapter	103D,	Hawaii	Revised
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- 2 Statutes, the department of human services, in consultation with
- 3 the department of health, shall issue a request for proposal to
- 4 contract for services and housing for homeless individuals with
- 5 severe mental health illness who have been discharged from acute
- 6 care and require further medical treatment and other supportive
- 7 services.
- 8 (b) The department of human services may adopt rules
- 9 pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to effectuate
- 10 this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for costs
- 14 necessary for services and housing for homeless individuals with
- 15 severe mental illness who have been discharged from acute care
- 16 and require further medical treatment and other supportive
- 17 services.
- 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 19 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
