A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPPLEMENTAL NUTRITION ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that consumption of fresh
- 2 fruit and vegetables is an integral part of a healthy diet and
- 3 central to the prevention of obesity and disease. Every
- 4 community should have adequate access to such healthy dietary
- 5 options; however, high cost and poor quality often make this
- 6 difficult.
- 7 The legislature further finds that, to increase access to
- 8 fresh fruits and vegetables for beneficiaries of the federal
- 9 Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program, some states have
- 10 enacted farmers' market matching incentive programs. Under such
- 11 programs, individuals who purchase produce at local farmers'
- 12 markets using their nutrition assistance benefits receive
- 13 additional benefits on a dollar-for-dollar basis up to a certain
- 14 amount.
- The legislature further finds that farmers' market matching
- 16 incentive programs have not only increased access to healthy
- 17 dietary options for participants, but have also helped



- 1 invigorate local economies and address food insecurity.
- 2 Previous legislation introduced in Hawaii to establish such a
- 3 program was also supported by community and scientific groups.
- 4 Therefore, the purpose of this Act is to require the
- 5 department of agriculture to develop and administer a local
- 6 health food incentive program promoting the purchase of fruits
- 7 and vegetables for beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition
- 8 Assistance Program.
- 9 SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 11 and to read as follows:
- 12 "§141- Local health food incentive program; special
- 13 fund. (a) There is established a local health food incentive
- 14 program for beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition
- 15 Assistance Program. The program shall be developed and
- 16 administered by the department of agriculture.
- 17 (b) Under the local health food incentive program,
- 18 beneficiaries of the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
- 19 who use food stamps to make purchases at a farmers' market and
- 20 other direct food retailers who participate in the Supplemental
- 21 Nutrition Assistance Program shall receive a dollar-for-dollar

- 1 match up to \$20 per month to be used exclusively for purchases
- 2 of fresh fruits and vegetables at a farmers' market or other
- 3 direct food retailer. For the purposes of this section,
- 4 "farmers' market" shall have the same meaning as in section
- 5 205-2(d)(15)(D).
- 6 (c) There is established within the department of
- 7 agriculture a local health food incentive program special fund,
- 8 into which shall be deposited any legislative appropriations and
- 9 any public or private grants, awards, or gifts for the purpose
- 10 of the local health food incentive program. Moneys in the
- 11 special fund may be expended by the department to administer the
- 12 program and to provide matching funds to beneficiaries.
- 13 (d) The department of agriculture may cooperate with
- 14 private organizations to develop rules for the local health food
- 15 incentive program."
- 16 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 18 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to be
- 19 deposited into the local health food incentive program special
- **20** fund.

- 1 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the local health
- 2 food incentive program special fund the sum of \$ or so
- 3 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
- 4 administration of the local health food incentive program and to
- 5 provide matching funds to beneficiaries of the Supplemental
- 6 Nutrition Assistance Program.
- 7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 8 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 9 SECTION 5. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
