Section 134-7.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) Any person disqualified from ownership, possession, 4 or control of firearms and ammunition under section 134-7, 5 within hours of disqualification, shall voluntarily surrender all firearms and ammunition to the chief of police 6 where the person resides or dispose of all firearms and 7 8 ammunition. If any person fails to voluntarily surrender or 9

- SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 12
