## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 134-7.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Any person disqualified from ownership, possession,
- 4 or control of firearms and ammunition under section 134-7,
- 5 within seven business days of disqualification, shall
- 6 voluntarily surrender all firearms and ammunition to the chief
- 7 of police where the person resides or dispose of all firearms
- 8 and ammunition. If any person fails to voluntarily surrender or
- 9 dispose of all firearms and ammunition within [thirty] seven
- 10 business days from the date of disqualification, the chief of
- 11 police may seize all firearms and ammunition."
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 14 begun before its effective date.
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
