
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-7.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) Any person disqualified from ownership, possession,
4 or control of firearms and ammunition under section 134-7,
5 within seven business days of disqualification, shall
6 voluntarily surrender all firearms and ammunition to the chief
7 of police where the person resides or dispose of all firearms
8 and ammunition. If any person fails to voluntarily surrender or
9 dispose of all firearms and ammunition within [~~thirty~~] seven
10 business days from the date of disqualification, the chief of
11 police may seize all firearms and ammunition."

12 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
13 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
14 begun before its effective date.

15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
