A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PENAL CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 710, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 Resisting an order to stop a motor vehicle under 5 unauthorized control. (1) A person commits the offense of 6 resisting an order to stop a motor vehicle under unauthorized 7 control if the person: Intentionally fails to obey a direction of a law 8 (a) 9 enforcement officer, acting under color of the law 10 enforcement officer's official authority to stop the 11 vehicle; and The person is operating the motor vehicle in violation 12 (b) 13 of section 708-836. 14 Resisting an order to stop a motor vehicle under (2) unauthorized control is a class B felony." 15 SECTION 2. Section 706-606.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 16 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows: 17
