## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GOVERNMENT RECORDS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. In <i>Molfino v. Yuen</i> , 134 Hawai'i 181 (2014), the		
2	supreme court of the State of Hawaii upheld a circuit court		
3	ruling that, absent a statutory requirement, a government agency		
4	does not have a duty of reasonable care with respect to		
5	maintaining government records for the purpose of public		
6	inspection. The purpose of this Act is to create a statutory		
7	requirement that government agencies exercise reasonable care in		
8	maintaining those government records open to public inspection.		
9	SECTION 2. Chapter 92, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended		
10	by adding a new section to part V to be appropriately designated		
11	and to read as follows:		
12	"§92- Duty to exercise reasonable care in maintaining		
13	records. (a) Each unit of government in the State and its		
14	political subdivisions shall:		
15	(1) Exercise reasonable care in the maintenance of all		
16	government records under its control that are required		
<b>17</b>	by chapter 92F to be available for public inspection;		

1	(2)	Issue instructions and guidelines necessary to
2		effectuate this section; and
3	(3)	Take steps to ensure that all its employees and
4		officers who are responsible for the collection,
5		maintenance, use, and dissemination of government
6		records are informed of the requirements of this
7		section.
8	(b)	Adherence to a duly adopted records retention and
9	destructi	on policy shall create a rebuttable presumption that
10	the unit	of government of the State or its political
11	subdivisi	ons exercised reasonable care in its maintenance of
12	governmen	t records for purposes of this section and in defending
13	a cause o	f action raised pursuant to this section."
14	SECT	ION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15	matured,	penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16	begun bef	ore its effective date.
17	SECT	ION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECT	ION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
