RELATING TO LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 281, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part II to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§281- Rules or regulations restricting liquor
- 5 consumption by hired stage performers while performing
- 6 prohibited. (a) A liquor commission shall not adopt or enforce
- 7 any rule or regulation that prohibits any hired stage performer
- 8 from consuming any liquor while that performer is performing on
- 9 stage at a licensed premises; provided that the hired stage
- 10 performer is not otherwise prohibited from consuming liquor by
- 11 law.
- (b) For purposes of this section "hired stage performer"
- 13 means any person hired for the specific purpose of performing on
- 14 stage at a licensed premises for a specified period of time or
- 15 number of performances and who performs no other service for the
- 16 licensed premises."
- 17 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
