RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE INSPECTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) All other vehicles, including motorcycles, mopeds,
- 4 trailers, semitrailers, and pole trailers having a gross vehicle
- 5 weight rating of 10,000 pounds or less, and antique motor
- 6 vehicles as defined in section 249-1, except those in
- 7 subsections (c) and (d), shall be certified as provided in
- 8 subsection (e) every twelve months; provided that any vehicle to
- 9 which this subsection applies, except a moped, shall not require
- 10 inspection within two years of the date on which the vehicle was
- 11 first sold[-]; provided further that the department shall adopt
- 12 rules for the purposes of this subsection."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
