A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that state revenue
- 2 projections indicate that there will be a shortfall over the
- 3 next few years. Therefore, it is critical to begin to control
- 4 costs now. Further, eliminating the ability to make transfers
- 5 of appropriated funds provides necessary legislative control
- 6 over costs, specifically personnel costs and associated
- 7 benefits.
- 8 The purpose of this Act is to eliminate the authority of
- 9 the University of Hawaii, the department of education, and the
- 10 Hawaii health systems corporation to make certain transfers of
- 11 appropriated funds.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 37-74, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 14 "(d) No appropriation transfers or changes between
- 15 programs or agencies shall be made without legislative
- 16 authorization; provided that [+

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1	(1)	Authorized] authorized transfers or changes, when
2		made, shall be reported to the legislature[+
3	(2)	Except with respect to appropriations to fund
4		financing agreements under chapter 37D, the University
5		of Hawaii may transfer appropriated funds and
6		positions for the operating cost category among
7		programs, among cost elements in a program, and
8		between quarters, as applicable; except with respect
9		to appropriations to fund financing agreements under
10		chapter 37D, the department of education may transfer
11		appropriated funds and positions for the operating
12		cost category among programs and among cost elements
13		in a program, and between quarters, as applicable; and
14		the Hawaii health systems corporation and its regional
15		system boards may transfer special fund appropriations
16		among regional system hospital facilities as
17		applicable and as mutually agreed to by the
18		corporation and the respective regional system board;
19		provided that the Hawaii health systems corporation
20		and the regional system boards shall maintain the
21		integrity and services of each individual regional

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1	system and shall not transfer appropriations out of
2	any regional system that would result in a reduction
3	of services offered by the regional system, with due
4	regard for statutory requirements, changing
5	conditions, the needs of the programs, and the
6	effective utilization of resources; and
7	(3) The university and the department of education shall
8	account for each transfer implemented under this
9	subsection in quarterly reports to the governor and
10	annual reports at the end of each fiscal year to the
11	legislature and the governor, which shall be prepared
12	in the form and manner prescribed by the governor and
13	shall include information on the sources and uses of
14	the transfer]."
15	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
