A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$250,000 or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 to
- 4 establish an annual import substitution grant program to
- 5 encourage Hawaii farmers and growers to identify and grow food
- 6 and nonfood alternative products to phase out imports of high-
- 7 risk pathway food and commodities by 2027.
- 8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 9 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$150,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
- 13 department of agriculture to contract with a professional public
- 14 relations firm to produce outreach materials to encourage Hawaii
- 15 residents to buy local products and foster a sense of pride and
- 16 self-responsibility in protecting Hawaii's agriculture,
- 17 environment, and lifestyle.



- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
