1 SECTION 1. Section 84-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 4 and to read: 5 ""Intern" means: 6 (1) Any person who performs unpaid services for the State 7 or more hours per week as part of an for internship program established by a private or public 8 9 secondary or post-secondary educational institution; 10 or11 A private sector employee who has taken an unpaid (2) 12 leave of absence from their other employment to 13 instead work for the State for a fixed period of time 14 not to exceed days." 15 By amending the definition of "employee" to read: 16 ""Employee" means any nominated, appointed, or elected 17 officer or employee of the State, including members of boards,

- 1 commissions, and committees[7]; interns; and employees under
- 2 contract to the State or of the constitutional convention, but
- 3 excluding legislators, delegates to the constitutional
- 4 convention, justices and judges."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2035.
