
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds
2 to the department of health for the purchase of ambulance
3 vehicles and their operational costs, including equipment,
4 supplies, and personnel costs for state-certified emergency
5 medical services personnel, for one twenty-four-hour, seven-
6 days-a-week ambulance unit for each of the counties of Kauai and
7 Hawaii.

8 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
9 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
10 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for
11 two twenty-four-hour, seven-days-a-week ambulance units,
12 including the purchase of one ambulance vehicle for each unit
13 and operating costs, including equipment, supplies, and
14 personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical services
15 personnel, to be allocated as follows:

- 16 (1) One unit for the county of Kauai; and
17 (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii.



1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
2 health for the purposes of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
