A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HUMANE TREATMENT OF ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§711- Confinement of a dog by tethering; violation.
- 5 (1) Except as provided in subsections (2) and (3), a person
- 6 commits the offense of confinement of a dog by tethering if the
- 7 person intentionally, knowingly, or recklessly tethers, fastens,
- 8 ties, or restrains a dog in a cruel or inhumane manner to a
- 9 structure, pole, dog house, tree, fence, or other stationary
- 10 object.
- 11 (2) A person may use a trolley system or a tether attached
- 12 to a pulley in a cable run without violating this section if the
- following conditions are met:
- 14 (a) Only one dog shall be tethered to each cable run;
- 15 (b) The tether or trolley system shall be designed for
- dogs and no logging chains shall be used;
