A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIPS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

2 SECTION 1. The department of business, economic development, and tourism is authorized to establish and fill 3 five full-time equivalent (5.0 FTE) state public-private 4 5 partnership coordinator positions, exempt from chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to be placed under the director of 6 business, economic development, and tourism to manage certain 7 public-private partnerships entered into by the State and manage 8 9 certain contracts, proposals, and negotiations associated with 10 the State's public-private partnerships. Public-private 11 partnerships entered into by the Hawaii public housing authority 12 are exempt from this Act.

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PART II

SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

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

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.

Description:

Authorizes establishment of five state public-private partnership coordinator positions within the department of business, economic development, and tourism to manage certain public-private partnerships entered into by the State and associated contracts, proposals, and negotiations, except public-private partnerships entered into by Hawaii public housing authority. Establishes an office of public-private partnership within the department of business, economic development, and tourism. Appropriates funds.
