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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMPLOYEE'S DESIGNATION OF BENEFICIARY FORM.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 78-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3           "(c) Upon discharge, an employee shall be entitled to all  
4 of the employee's accumulated vacation allowance plus the  
5 employee's current accrued vacation allowance to and including  
6 the date of discharge, notwithstanding that the current accrued  
7 vacation allowance may not have been recorded at the time. If  
8 any employee dies with accumulated or current accrued vacation  
9 earned but not taken, an amount equal to the value of the  
10 employee's pay over the period of [~~such~~] the earned vacation,  
11 and any earned and unpaid wages, shall be paid [~~to~~]:

12           (1) To the person or persons who may have been designated  
13 as the beneficiary or beneficiaries by the employee  
14 during the employee's lifetime in a [~~verified written~~]  
15 statement filed either with the comptroller or other  
16 disbursing officer who issues warrants or checks to  
17 pay the employee for the employee's services as a



1 public employee[7] or with the department in which the  
2 employee was employed; or[, failing]

3 (2) In the absence of a designation, to the employee's  
4 estate."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
