# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONFIDENTIAL PERSONAL INFORMATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-800, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "confidential personal 3 information" to read as follows: 4 ""Confidential personal information" means information in 5 which [an individual] a person has a significant privacy 6 interest, including but not limited to a person's entire 7 driver's license number [, -a] or social security number [, -an];8 the entire identifying number of a person's depository, 9 investment, or credit account [, a bank account number, a 10 password or other information that is used for accessing 11 information, or any other name, number, or code that is used, 12 alone or in conjunction with other information, to confirm the identity of a person.]; a person's entire credit card number or 13 14 medical record number; or a username and password that, when 15 used in conjunction, provide access to a person's credit card 16 account; medical records; or depository, investment, or credit 17 account."

SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun, before the effective date of this Act.
SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
