A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII PUBLIC HOUSING AUTHORITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 Section 356D-6.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is SECTION 1. 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: Smoking shall be prohibited in any public housing 3 4 project, elder or elderly [household,] housing, as defined in 5 section 356D-1, or state low-income housing project, as defined 6 in section 356D-51, within: 7 (1)Each individual housing unit; 8 (2) All common areas; (3) Community facilities; and 10 (4) [Twenty] Twenty-five feet from each individual 11 building and each administrative office building of 12 the public housing project, elder or elderly housing, 13 or state low-income housing project, and from any entrance, exit, window, and ventilation intake that 14 **15** serves an enclosed or partially enclosed area. 16 Notwithstanding subsection (a), the authority may (b)

designate one or more permissible smoking areas at least

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- 1 [twenty] twenty-five feet away from any residential or other
- 2 building, or any greater distance away as may ensure that the
- 3 secondhand smoke does not infiltrate any dwelling unit [-] or
- 4 office."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Prohibits smoking in and increases the smoke-free zone around certain areas and buildings in public housing projects, state low-income housing projects, and elder or elderly housing from 20 to 25 feet. (SB2783 HD1)
