## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPERVISION OF LICENSED DENTAL HYGIENISTS IN A PUBLIC HEALTH SETTING.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 447-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows:

- 6 services in a public health setting. General supervision is
- 7 permitted in a public health setting; provided that the
- 8 supervising licensed dentist is available for consultation;
- 9 provided further that a licensed dental hygienist shall not
- 10 perform any irreversible procedure or administer any intra-oral
- 11 block anesthesia under general supervision. In a public health
- 12 <u>setting</u>, the supervising licensed dentist shall be responsible
- 13 for all delegated acts and procedures performed by a licensed
- 14 dental hygienist. [As used in this subsection, "public health
- 15 setting" includes dental services in a legally incorporated
- 16 eleemosynary dental dispensary or infirmary, private school,

1 welfare center, hospital, nursing home, adult day care center or 2 assisted living facility, mental institution, nonprofit health 3 clinic, or the State or any county. A] Notwithstanding section 4 447-1(f), a licensed dental hygienist under the general 5 supervision of a licensed dentist employed in a public health 6 setting may perform dental education, dental screenings, teeth 7 cleanings, intra-oral or extra-oral photographs, x-rays if 8 indicated, and fluoride applications [-] on individuals who are 9 not yet patients of record, have not yet been examined by a 10 licensed dentist, or do not have a treatment plan. Other 11 permissible duties shall be pre-screened and authorized by a 12 supervising licensed dentist, subject to the dentist's 13 determination that the equipment and facilities are appropriate 14 and satisfactory to carry out the recommended treatment plan. A 15 licensed dental hygienist shall refer individuals not currently **16** under the care of a dentist and who are seen in a public health **17** setting to a dental facility for further dental care. No direct 18 reimbursements shall be provided to licensed dental hygienists. 19 As used in this subsection, "public health setting" **20** includes but is not limited to dental services in a legally 21 incorporated eleemosynary dental dispensary or infirmary,

- 1 private or public school, welfare center, community center,
- 2 public housing, hospital, nursing home, adult day care center or
- 3 assisted living facility, mental institution, nonprofit health
- 4 clinic or facility, or the State or any county."
- 5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 3000.
