# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DISPOSITION WITHIN STATE BOATING FACILITIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 200-2.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the board
4	may lease fast lands and submerged lands within an existing state

### JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT:

Land and Natural Resources

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO DISPOSITION WITHIN STATE BOATING FACILITIES.

PURPOSE:

To clarify that the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) may lease all fast lands and submerged lands within any existing state boating facility pursuant to a request for proposals without regard to section 200-2.6, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

MEANS:

Amend section 200-2.5(a) and repeal section 200-2.6, HRS.

JUSTIFICATION:

Currently, section 200-2.5(a), HRS, authorizes the Board to lease "fast lands and submerged lands within an existing state boating facility" by public auction, a request for proposals, or by direct negotiation pursuant to section 171-59, HRS, and chapter 190D, HRS, for private development, management, and operation, provided that any lease of fast lands or submerged lands pursuant to a request for proposals shall be subject to section 200-2.6, HRS, regardless to which state boating facility the fast or submerged lands are attached. In turn however, section 200-2.6, HRS, only addresses leases of the Ala Wai boat harbor. The reference to section 200-2.6, HRS, within section 200-2.5(a), HRS, is ambiguous and confusing.

The proposed amendments in this measure would remove the reference to section 200-2.6, HRS, within section 200-2.5, HRS, to not limit the fast lands and submerged lands of the Ala Wai boat harbor that may be leased.

Impact on the public: The proposed amendments would provide the Department with more flexibility and options to upgrade and improve state boating facilities to the benefit of boaters.

Impact on the department and other agencies: The proposed amendments would provide the Department with more flexibility and options in managing, maintaining, and improving state boating facilities.
