# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO IRRIGATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTI	ION 1. (a) The following positions are established
2	within the	e agricultural resource management division of the
3	department of agriculture:	
4	(1)	One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) irrigation district
5		manager position (SR21);
6	(2)	Three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) irrigation system
7		worker II positions (BC07); and
8	(3)	One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) office assistant
9		III position (SR-08).
10	(b)	The portions of the east Kauai irrigation system
11	operated and maintained by the east Kauai water users'	
12	cooperative as of July 1, 2018, shall be placed under the	
13	operational authority of the department of agriculture until	
14	such time that adoption of rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii	
15	Revised Statutes, are completed, or a determination is made that	
16	the system can be appropriately operated and maintained pursuant	
17	to chapters 167 and 168, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Until the

1 system is transferred to the appropriate program, the 2 operational authority shall not be governed by chapter 167 or 3 168, Hawaii Revised Statutes, for acreage assessment or water 4 delivery fees. The department of agriculture may contract with 5 the east Kauai water users' cooperative to bill and collect any 6 fees from the users and enter into any and all contracts 7 necessary to operate and maintain the system, including 8 operation and maintenance contracts while positions are filled. 9 All fees collected by the east Kauai water users' cooperative shall be deposited in the general fund of the State by the 10 department of agriculture. 11

12 (c) The three-year water licensing deadline may be 13 extended for up to two years; provided that the applicant 14 demonstrates significant progress in the permit application 15 process.

SECTION 2. All appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal property heretofore made, used, acquired, or held by the east Kauai water users' cooperative relating to the functions transferred to the department of agriculture shall be listed in a full accounting to the

department of agriculture with the functions to which they
 relate.

SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue 3 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$2,000,000 or so much 4 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof 5 6 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the purpose of assisting the agricultural resource 7 management division with plans, designs, land acquisition, and 8 9 equipment to increase state irrigation system capacity 10 statewide, including:

- 11 (1) \$1,997,000 for planning;
- 12 (2) \$1,000 for design;
- 13 (3) \$1,000 for land acquisition; and
- 14 (4) \$1,000 for equipment.

15 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 16 agriculture for the purposes of this Act.

17 SECTION 4. The appropriation made for the capital 18 improvement project authorized by section 3 of this Act shall 19 not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the 20 appropriation is made; provided that all moneys from the

appropriation unencumbered as of June 30, 2023, shall lapse as
 of that date.

3 SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the general 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the 6 operations and maintenance of the east Kauai irrigation system, 7 including the following agricultural resource management 8 division staff salaries and expenses:

- 9 (1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) irrigation district
  10 manager position (SR21) established pursuant to this
  11 Act;
- 12 (2) Three full-time equivalent (3.0 FTE) irrigation system
  13 worker II positions (BC07) established pursuant to
  14 this Act;
- 15 (3) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) office assistant
  16 III position (SR-08) established pursuant to this Act;
  17 (4) Fifty per cent of the funding for the engineering
  18 program manager position (EM07-PN: 40998), which
  19 shall be transferred from the non-agricultural park
  20 lands special fund to the general fund; and

 (5) Fifty per cent of the funding for the agricultural lands program manager position (EM05-PN: 122475),
 which shall be transferred from the agricultural park special fund to the general fund.
 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of agriculture for the purposes of this Act.
 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.

#### Report Title:
