A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD CARE PROVIDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Act 161, Session
2 Laws of Hawaii 2017, amends section 346-157, Hawaii Revised
3 Statutes, to require that child care providers must disclose to
4 parents and guardians who apply to have their child cared for at
5 those child care facilities, a summary of information that
6 includes the liability insurer's name and contact information,
7 coverage amounts, and effective dates for liability insurance
8 coverage. However, this disclosure of information may be
9 unnecessary as providers already provide proof of minimum
10 insurance coverage to the department of human services as part
11 of the licensing approval process.

12 The purpose of this Act is to repeal language that requires
13 child care providers to disclose a summary of information
14 relating to liability insurance coverage to parents and
15 guardians applying for child care at a child care facility.

16 SECTION 2. Section 346-157, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:



1 "(c) The department, as a condition of continued
2 licensure, temporary permission, or registration, shall require
3 all providers to disclose in writing to each parent or
4 guardian[+]

5 ~~(1) Applying to have a child cared for at the provider's~~
6 ~~facility, summary information including the insurer's~~
7 ~~name and contact information, coverage amounts, and~~
8 ~~effective dates for the provider's liability insurance~~
9 ~~coverage at the time of application; or]~~

10 (2) Within, within seven working days of any change,
11 cancellation, or termination of liability insurance
12 coverage, that the coverage has been changed,
13 canceled, or terminated while the parent's or
14 guardian's child is cared for at the provider's
15 facility."

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
