# A BILL FOR AN ACT

---

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1       SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds  
2 to the department of health for the purchase of ambulance  
3 vehicles and their operational costs, including equipment,  
4 supplies, and personnel costs for state-certified emergency  
5 medical services personnel, for three twenty-four hour, seven  
6 days a week ambulance units, to be allocated as follows:

7           (1) One unit for the county of Kauai;

8           (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii; and

9           (3) One unit for the city and county of Honolulu.

10       SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$           or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for  
13 three twenty-four hour, seven days a week ambulance units,  
14 including the purchase of one ambulance vehicle for each unit  
15 and operating costs, including equipment, supplies, and  
16 personnel costs for state-certified emergency medical services  
17 personnel, to be allocated as follows:



# S.B. NO. 2876

- (1) One unit for the county of Kauai;
- (2) One unit for the county of Hawaii; and
- (3) One unit for the city and county of Honolulu.

The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of health for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
