## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the Hawaii
- 2 technology development corporation is a key state agency in
- 3 developing and supporting initiatives aimed at promoting
- 4 technology and innovation jobs in the State. In 2017, the
- 5 legislature provided funding for and made changes to the small
- 6 business innovation research program. The legislature supports
- 7 continuation of the small business innovation research program
- 8 as an important initiative of the State to assist Hawaii small
- 9 businesses in advancing technology and developing new products.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to support and sustain the small
- 11 business innovation research program operated by the Hawaii
- 12 technology development corporation.
- 13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for the
- 16 continuance of the small business innovation research program;
- 17 provided that the Hawaii technology development corporation



- 1 shall plan to provide funds for phase three grants where
- 2 applicable.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 4 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
