# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GOVERNOR'S COORDINATOR ON HOMELESSNESS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness in
- 2 Hawaii has reached epidemic proportions. Homelessness impacts
- 3 residents and visitors alike and more must be done to mitigate
- 4 homelessness through various services. Since 2011, the governor
- 5 has appointed a coordinator on homelessness to coordinate
- 6 homelessness efforts statewide. The Hawaii interagency council
- 7 on homelessness was established by Act 105, Session Laws of
- 8 Hawaii 2012 (codified as part XVIII of chapter 346, Hawaii
- 9 Revised Statutes), with the governor's coordinator on
- 10 homelessness designated to serve as chair. However, the
- 11 governor's coordinator on homelessness position has not been
- 12 statutorily established.
- 13 The purpose of this Act is to establish clear lines of
- 14 accountability and to empower the governor's coordinator on
- 15 homelessness by:
- 16 (1) Statutorily establishing the position; and

18	<u>(c)</u>	The office of the governor shall provide office space
19	to the go	vernor's coordinator on homelessness and related staff
20	provided	that if the office of the governor is unable to provide
21	adequate	office space, the department shall provide adequate

1 office space to the governor's coordinator on homelessness and 2 related staff." SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 3 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019: 6 (1) To establish the governor's coordinator on homelessness as a -time equivalent ( FTE) 8 position; and 9 (2) For other expenses of the governor's coordinator on 10 homelessness, including hiring of necessary staff. 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 12 human services for the purposes of this Act. SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored. 13

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
