A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINETEENTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$23,245,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the
6 nineteenth senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. James Campbell High School

8 A. Plans for a campus master plan,
9 including athletic facilities,
10 ground and site improvements, and
11 equipment and appurtenances.

1 SECTION 2. The appropriations made for the capital
2 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
3 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
4 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
5 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

6 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
7 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
8 expended by the department of education.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
