6 SECTION 2. The appropriation made for the capital
7 improvement projects authorized by this Act shall not lapse at
8 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is
9 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation
10 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

11 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
12 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended for
13 the purposes of this Act as follows:

14 (1) The sums appropriated in items 1 through 3 shall be
15 expended by the department of education; and

16 (2) The sums appropriated in items 4 through 7 shall be
17 expended by the department of accounting and general
18 services.

19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
