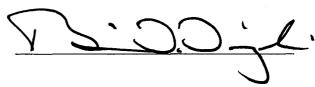

| 8  | identifies an issue or question that will appear on              |
| 9  | the ballot at the next applicable election; and                  |
| 10 | (2) Advocates or supports the nomination, opposition, or         |
| 11 | election of the candidate, or advocates the passage of           |
| 12 | defeat of the issue or question on the ballot."                  |
| 13 | SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed        |
| 14 | and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.             |
| 15 | SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.         |
