17 the end of the fiscal year for which the appropriations are
18 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations that are
19 unencumbered as of June 30, 2020, shall lapse as of that date.

20 SECTION 3. The sums appropriated for the respective
21 capital improvement projects set forth in section 1 shall be
22 expended by the department of education.
