## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HOMELESSNESS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

| 1  | SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require the           |
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| 2  | auditor to conduct a study to assess the impact of using       |
| 3  | medicaid funds to provide coverage for the treatment for       |
| 4  | homelessness.  |
| 5  | SECTION 2. (a) The auditor, with the assistance of the         |
| 6  | department of human services, shall conduct a study to assess  |
| 7  | the impact of using medicaid funds to provide coverage for the |
| 8  | treatment for homelessness, including the costs to provide     |
| 9  | coverage for the chronically homeless population in the State; |
| 10 | provided that for the purposes of this Act, "treatment" or     |
| 11 | "treatment for homelessness" includes:                         |
| 12 | (1) Behavioral health services, including mental health        |
| 13 | and substance abuse services;                                  |
| 14 | (2) Case management;   |
| 15 | (3) Personal care and personal assistance services;            |
| 16 | (4) Home and community-based services; and                     |
| 17 | (5) Housing services.  |

1 The auditor shall submit findings and recommendations, (b) 2 including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later 3 than twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session 4 of 2018. 5 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ 7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 for the purpose of conducting a study to assess the impact of using 8 9 medicaid funds to provide coverage for the treatment of 10 homelessness; provided that: 11 (1) No funds appropriated under this Act shall be expended 12 unless matched dollar-for-dollar with federal funds; 13 and 14 (2) The department of human services may assist the 15 auditor in pursuing federal funds for the purpose of 16 conducting the study. **17** The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of the 18 auditor for the purposes of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2090.
