A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE
NINTH SENATORIAL DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$43,010,000 or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum or so much thereof
4 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2018-2019
5 for the purpose of capital improvement projects for the ninth
6 senatorial district, as follows:

7 1. Diamond Head state monument

8 A. Master plan.

9 Plans and design \$2,000

10 Construction \$948,000

11 Total funding \$950,000
