RELATING TO UTILITY POLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that new utility poles 2 are often installed adjacent to an existing utility pole and the 3 original pole is left in place. This results in what is 4 sometimes referred to as double poles. In some instances, a third pole is installed next to two existing poles, resulting in 5 a triple pole. In most cases, this occurs when the electric 6 utility deems it necessary to install a new pole: the electric 7 8 utility transfers its wiring to the new pole and the other 9 utilities, such as telephone, cable television, and municipal 10 street lights, remain on the original pole.

11 The joint pole committee is entrusted with coordination of 12 access and responsibilities between all affected agencies 13 regarding utility poles. One guideline is that the last utility 14 provider to relocate its equipment to the new pole should be 15 responsible for removal of the original pole. As such, many 16 double poles remain indefinitely because no utility provider

wants to be the last agency to relocate its equipment and become
 responsible for the removal of the original pole.

The legislature further finds that many of the original poles that remain in place are unsafe due to termite damage, rot, collision damage from vehicles, and many other safety concerns, and many of the original poles remain even after all other utility equipment has been relocated. These double and triple poles mar the natural beauty of the State and create a safety hazard, and should not be permitted.

10 The purpose of this Act is to prohibit new utility pole 11 installation within ten feet of an existing utility pole unless 12 the relevant utility service providers remove the original pole 13 within ninety days of installation of the new pole.

SECTION 2. Chapter 269, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:

17 "<u>§269-</u> Installation of new utility poles; removal of old
18 utility poles. (a) A public utility shall not install,
19 construct, erect, or otherwise build a new utility pole within
20 ten feet of an existing utility pole unless the original utility
21 pole will be uninstalled and removed within ninety days of

1	installing, constructing, erecting, or otherwise building the
2	new utility pole. The joint pole committee shall maintain
3	records of the installation date of all poles installed within
4	ten feet of an existing utility pole and the date the original
5	utility pole is removed.
6	(b) For the purposes of this section, "original utility
7	pole" means the utility pole from which a public utility's
8	equipment was transferred."
9	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
10	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
