### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMERCIALIZATION OF TECHNOLOGY AND INNOVATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that to be successful in 2 the twenty-first century global economy, Hawaii must position 3 itself as a leader in the development, transfer, and 4 commercialization of technology. Significant progress has been 5 made through programs supported by federal and state 6 initiatives, such as programs administered by the Hawaii 7 technology development corporation, Hawaii strategic development 8 corporation, and Hawaii technology development venture, but more 9 is required to move Hawaii's technology industry to achieve local technology commercialization. Innovation in science and 10 11 technology fields will not only enable the State to succeed in 12 the global marketplace, but will also support the State's 13 sustainable economic development goals to include a viable and 14 vibrant technology and manufacturing labor force.

15 The purpose of this Act is to establish the Hawaii 16 innovation and technology authority to create coherent policy, 17 prioritize investments, and promote efficient use of the State's



1 resources to institute and grow Hawaii's innovation and 2 technology industry, which will promote a more diverse economy 3 that offers high quality knowledge-based jobs. Specifically, 4 the authority will be tasked with the development of policy and 5 allocation of resources to enable and support start-ups, sustain 6 existing companies, and attract companies to relocate or 7 establish offices in Hawaii. 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 201, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and 10 to read as follows: 11 . HAWAII INNOVATION AND TECHNOLOGY AUTHORITY "PART 12 §201-Definitions. As used in this part, unless the 13 context requires otherwise: 14 "Authority" means the Hawaii innovation and technology 15 authority. 16 "Board" means the board of directors of the Hawaii 17 innovation and technology authority. 18 "Department" means the department of business, economic 19 development, and tourism. 20 §201-Hawaii innovation and technology authority; board; 21 president and chief executive officer. (a) There is



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1 established the Hawaii innovation and technology authority, 2 which shall be a body corporate and a public instrumentality of 3 the State, for the purposes of implementing this part. The authority shall be placed within the department of business, 4 economic development, and tourism, for administrative purposes 5 6 only. 7 The authority shall be headed by a policy-making board (b) 8 of directors that shall consist of members; provided 9 that: 10 The members shall be appointed by the governor as (1)11 provided in section 26-34; provided that each member 12 shall hold office until the member's successor is 13 appointed and confirmed by the senate; 14 (2) The members shall include at least one representative 15 each from the city and county of Honolulu and the 16 counties of Hawaii, Kauai, and Maui; 17 (3) Three members shall be appointed by the governor from 18 a list of three nominees submitted by the president of 19 the senate, and three members shall be appointed by 20 the governor from a list of three nominees submitted 21 by the speaker of the house of representatives;



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(4) All members shall have knowledge, experience, and
 expertise in the area of technology, innovation,
 information systems, computer science, aerospace,
 agriculture, tourism, environmental science, or
 sustainability; and

6 (5) The governor shall make appointments to ensure the 7 fulfillment of all requirements of paragraphs (2) and 8 (4); provided that upon the occurrence of a vacancy 9 subject to paragraph (3), the governor shall notify 10 the president of the senate and the speaker of the 11 house of representatives of any unfulfilled 12 requirements pursuant to paragraphs (2) and (4), and 13 the president of the senate or the speaker of the 14 house of representatives, as appropriate, shall submit 15 nominees who fulfill those requirements.

16 (c) The board shall elect a chairperson from among the17 members.

18 (d) members shall constitute a quorum, and a
19 minimum of affirmative votes shall be necessary for all
20 actions by the authority. The members shall serve without



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1 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including 2 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties. 3 (e) The board shall appoint one person to serve as 4 president and chief executive officer, who shall oversee staff 5 of the authority. The compensation package, including salary, 6 of the president and chief executive officer shall not exceed 7 , and the compensation package shall not include private sector moneys or other contributions. The board shall 8 9 set the president and chief executive officer's duties, 10 responsibilities, holidays, vacations, leaves, hours of work, 11 and working conditions. The board may grant other benefits as 12 it deems necessary." 13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$15,000,000 or so 15 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for 16 operating costs of the Hawaii innovation and technology 17 authority. 18 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of 19 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of 20 this Act.

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1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2018.
