A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

PART I

SECTION 1. The department of health has reported over
seventy cases of rat lungworm disease caused by Angiostrongylus *cantonensis* from 2001 to 2014. There were many more cases in
2017, including at least eleven on Hawaii island, six on Maui,
and one on Oahu. The disease has claimed lives and caused
crippling chronic disability, and the cost of treatment for one
severe case can exceed \$1,000,000.

9 The purpose of this part is to create a statewide rat 10 lungworm disease working group to collaborate on research and 11 other activities related to the prevention and eradication of 12 rat lungworm disease, both on Hawaii island and across the 13 State.

SECTION 2. (a) The University of Hawaii shall be required to convene the statewide rat lungworm disease working group to collaborate on research and other activities related to the



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1 prevention and eradication of rat lungworm disease, both on 2 Hawaii island and across the State. 3 The statewide rat lungworm disease working group shall (b) 4 be composed of the following members: 5 (1)A representative of the Daniel K. Inouye college of 6 pharmacy at the University of Hawaii at Hilo; 7 (2)A representative of the department of health; 8 A representative of the department of agriculture; (3) 9 (4)A physician who is actively treating rat lungworm 10 disease in a patient or patients, to be selected by 11 the governor; and A veterinarian, to be selected by the board of 12 (5) 13 veterinary examiners, established by section 471-3, 14 Hawaii Revised Statutes. 15 (C) The statewide rat lungworm disease working group shall 16 be administratively attached to the office of the lieutenant 17 qovernor. 18 PART II 19 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general 20 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much 21 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2018-2019 for

19		disease in Hawaii;



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1	(7)	Developing clinical guidelines regarding the risk	
2		factors, diagnosis, treatment, and long-term	
3		consequences of rat lungworm disease;	
4	(8)	Conducting a case study on individuals who contracted	
5		rat lungworm disease by ingesting kava; and	
6.	(9)	Other related research, studies, and testing regarding	
7		the prevention and eradication of rat lungworm

9	provided that the appropriation shall be matched 1:1 between the		
10	State and anticipated sources of funding, including private		
11	sources and federal research grants; provided further that some		
12	of the appropriation shall be used to develop clinical		
13	guidelines regarding the risk factors, diagnosis, treatment, and		
14	long-term consequences of rat lungworm disease; provided further		
15	that some of the appropriation shall be used to conduct a case		
16	study on individuals who contracted rat lungworm disease by		
17	ingesting kava.		
18	The	sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of	
19	Hawaii for the purposes of this part.

21	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2112.
