## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTIONEERING COMMUNICATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- Section 11-341, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by amending subsection (d) to read as follows: For purposes of this section: 3 " (d) "Disclosure date" means, for every calendar year, [the 4 first date by which a person has made expenditures during that 5 6 same year of more than \$2,000 in the aggregate for electioneering communications, and the date of any subsequent 7 expenditures by that person for electioneering communications.] 8 any date on which an electioneering communication is publicly 9 distributed; provided that the person making the electioneering 10 11 communication has made one or more expenditures, or has executed one or more contracts to make expenditures, for the direct costs 12 of producing and distributing electioneering communications 13 14 aggregating more than \$2,000. 15 "Electioneering communication" means any advertisement that is broadcast from a cable, satellite, television, or radio 16
