A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO OXYBENZONE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 328, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§328- Sunscreen; oxybenzone; advertising or display
- 5 requirements. (a) All advertisements or displays for sunscreen
- 6 containing oxybenzone in the State shall include the following
- 7 conspicuously displayed statement: "Oxybenzone, when used in
- 8 nearshore waters, poses serious hazards to coral and reef
- 9 health."
- 10 (b) For purposes of this section, "oxybenzone" means the
- 11 chemical (2-Hydroxy-4-methoxyphenyl)-phenylmethanone under the
- 12 International Union of Pure and Applied Chemistry chemical
- 13 nomenclature registry, which has a chemical abstract service
- 14 registry number 131-57-7, and includes benzophenone-3 and 4-
- 15 methoxy-2-hydroxybenzophenone (trade names Escalol 567, Eusolex
- 16 4360, KAHSCREEN BZ-3, and Milestab 9) and is intended to be used
- 17 as a sunscreen to provide broad-spectrum ultraviolet coverage."
