A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

 ${f 1}$ SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by

2 adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read

HEALTH CARE PRACTITIONER EDUCATION DISCLOSURE REQUIREMENTS

§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:

7 "Health care practitioner" or "practitioner" means:

8 acupuncture practitioners licensed pursuant to chapter 436E;

9 chiropractors licensed pursuant to chapter 442; dental

10 hygienists licensed pursuant to chapter 447; dentists licensed

11 pursuant to chapter 448; licensed dietitians licensed pursuant

12 to chapter 448B; massage therapists licensed pursuant to chapter

13 452; physicians and osteopathic physicians licensed pursuant to

chapter 453; physician assistants licensed pursuant to chapter

15 453; naturopathic physicians licensed pursuant to chapter 455;

16 nurses licensed pursuant to chapter 457; occupational therapists

- 16 (2) Through a prominent display in an area visible to
- patients in the health care practitioner's office.

- 19 a health care practitioner who is licensed as a physician or
- 20 osteopathic physician under chapter 453 and is certified by:
- 21 (1) An American Board of Medical Specialties member board;
