BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§346- Homeless; housing-related services; supportive
- 5 services; medicaid budget. (a) Twenty per cent of the
- 6 department's annual medicaid budget shall be used for housing-
- 7 related services and other permanent supportive services.
- 8 (b) The activities and services required under subsection
- 9 (a) shall be used to assist homeless individuals with mental
- 10 illness or substance use disorders.
- 11 (c) The department shall seek a waiver pursuant to section
- 12 1115 of the Social Security Act, title 42 United States Code
- 13 section 1315, and other approvals from the Centers for Medicare
- 14 and Medicaid Services that may be necessary to implement the
- 15 requirements of this section."
- 16 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.
