A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the issuance of
 doctoral degrees by campuses of the University of Hawaii system
 is a matter of statewide concern.
 The purpose of this Act is to restrict doctoral degree
- programs to the University of Hawaii at Manoa. This Act also provides for a delayed effective date to allow current doctoral candidates of other campuses to earn their degrees.
- 8 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9 amended by adding a new section to part I, subpart A, to be 10 appropriately designated and to read as follows:
- 11 "§304A- Doctoral degrees; University of Hawaii at

 programs; and
