A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SMALL BUSINESS REGULATORY REVIEW BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the small business
- 2 regulatory review board serves an important function in state
- 3 government by providing small business input into the rulemaking
- 4 process. The legislature further finds that the board's mission
- 5 is important for small businesses and Hawaii's economy.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- department of business, economic development, and tourism to 7
- 8 provide additional resources for the small business regulatory
- 9 review board.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$50,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
- 13 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 14 2018-2019 for the department of business, economic development,
- 15 and tourism to provide additional resources for the small
- 16 business regulatory review board.



- 1 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 2 of business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes
- 3 of this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
