A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HIGH TECHNOLOGY DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the high technology development corporation is a key state agency in developing and 2 3 supporting the manufacturing industry in the State. The 4 legislature further finds that the continuation of the 5 manufacturing development program is vital. 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the manufacturing development program to support manufacturing in 7 8 the State.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,500,000 or so much
11 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2017-2018 and the
12 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
13 2018-2019 for the high technology development corporation to
14 continue the operation and administration of the manufacturing
15 development program.

16 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the high17 technology development corporation for the purposes of this Act.
