A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 163D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 3 and to read as follows:
- 4 "§163D- Grants. (a) There is established a grant
- 5 program to be administered by the corporation to provide
- 6 financial support for agriculture-related improvements to
- 7 existing and emerging farms and agribusiness operations.
- **8** (b) Applications for grants by qualified persons shall
- 9 include the name of the requesting organization or individual;
- 10 the public purpose for the grant; the service to be supported by
- 11 the grant; the target group; and the cost and budget of the
- 12 service. Applications shall be filed with accompanying
- 13 documentation of project cost as may be required by the
- 14 corporation for projects developed within the immediately
- 15 preceding fiscal quarter and shall represent reasonable
- 16 projections of project costs for the period in which the project
- 17 is anticipated to commence; provided that the applicant shall:



1	(1)	Comply with applicable federal and state laws
2		prohibiting discrimination against any person on the
3		basis of race, color, national origin, religion,
4		creed, sex, age, sexual orientation, or disability;
5	(2)	Have applied for or received all applicable licenses
6		or permits;
7	(3)	Indemnify and save harmless the State and its
8		officers, agents, and employees from and against any
9		and all claims arising out of or resulting from
10		activities carried out or projects undertaken with
11		funds provided under this section, and procure
12		sufficient insurance to provide this indemnification
13	,	if requested to do so by the corporation; and
14	(4)	Implement any of the following:
15		(A) Agriculture-related projects on an existing farm
16		or agribusiness operation;
17		(B) Plans to modernize or expand an existing farm or
18		agribusiness operation;
19		(C) Agriculture-related equipment modification or
20		replacement;

1	(D)	Programs designed to develop new markets or
2		products; or
3	<u>(E)</u>	Farmer and agriculture-related advisory,
4		consultative, training, and educational services,
5		technical assistance, and advice to any person,
6		partnership, or corporation either public or
7		private.
8	(c) Upon	award of a grant under this section, the
9	applicant shal	l submit quarterly reports to the corporation of
10	expenditures m	ade during the quarter and in the aggregate.
11	Quarterly repo	rts shall identify the particular project cost
12	expended and s	hall be submitted at the end of each of the
13	applicant's fi	scal quarters.
14	(d) The	grant may not exceed a total of \$100,000 per
15	qualified pers	on or entity per year."

17	SECTION 3	. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2017.
