A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE AEROSPACE ADVISORY COMMITTEE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 201-72.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established an aerospace advisory committee
4	within the office of aerospace development of the department of
5	business, economic development, and tourism for administrative
6	purposes. The committee shall be composed of thirteen members
7	[appointed by the governor, as provided in section 26-34, except
8	as otherwise] as provided in this section. Of the thirteen
9	members:
10	(1) Three members shall be representatives of the
11	aerospace industry $[-,]$ and appointed by the governor,
12	as provided in section 26-34. One member shall be
13	appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the
14	president of the senate, and one member shall be
15	appointed from a list of nominees submitted by the
16	speaker of the house of representatives;

1	(2)	Three members shall be representatives of the
2		aerospace industry in this State[-] and appointed by
3		the governor, as provided in section 26-34. One
4		member shall be appointed from a list of nominees
5		submitted by the president of the senate, and one
6		member shall be appointed from a list of nominees
7		submitted by the speaker of the house of
8		representatives;
9	(3)	Four members shall represent the economic development
10		boards of Kauai, Oahu, Maui, and Hawaii, respectively,
11		to be [appointed, respectively, from a list of
12		nominees submitted] selected by each of these economic
13		development boards; and
14	(4)	Three members shall represent the University of Hawaii
15		at Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and University
16		of Hawaii community college system, respectively, to
17		be [appointed, one each, from a list of nominees
18		submitted] selected by the University of Hawaii at
19		Manoa, University of Hawaii at Hilo, and University of
20		Hawaii community college system, respectively.
