SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

REQUESTING THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND CITY AND COUNTY
OF HONOLULU TO IMPLEMENT SAFEGUARDS AT HAUULA BEACH PARK TO
PROTECT HAWAIIAN MONK SEALS.

1 WHEREAS, Hawaiian monk seals are an endangered species found
2 only in the Hawaiian Islands; and
3

4 WHEREAS, a Hawaiian monk seal known as "Honey Girl" is a
5 regular visitor of the Hauula Beach Park and frequents a
6 particular section of the beach park adjacent to the
7 intersection of Kamehameha Highway and Kakuna Road; and

9 WHEREAS, members of the nearby community have expressed
10 concerns for the safety of Honey Girl and other Hawaiian monk
11 seals visiting Hauula Beach Park; and

13 WHEREAS, seals seeking warmth and shelter may tend to sleep
14 under parked vehicles in the area; and

16 WHEREAS, many visitors arrive at Hauula Beach Park on tour
17 buses and take pictures of or with the seals at an unsafe
18 distance, creating the risk of injury to both the seals and the
19 tourists; and

21 WHEREAS, safeguards are necessary at Hauula Beach Park to
22 protect Honey Girl and other Hawaiian monk seals visiting Hauula
23 Beach Park; now, therefore,

25 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
26 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the
27 House of Representatives concurring, that the Department of
28 Transportation and the City and County of Honolulu are requested



to implement safeguards at Hauula Beach Park to protect Hawaiian monk seals; and


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this Concurrent Resolution be transmitted to the Director of Transportation, the Mayor of Honolulu, and the Chairperson of the Honolulu City Council.
