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## SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

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REQUESTING THE OFFICE OF THE CITY AUDITOR TO CONDUCT A  
PERFORMANCE AUDIT OF THE BOARD OF WATER SUPPLY'S  
MAINTENANCE PROGRAM AND TRAFFIC MITIGATION MEASURES.

1 WHEREAS, the Board of Water Supply responded to 326 water  
2 main breaks during the 2016 fiscal year; and  
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4 WHEREAS, more than 1,500 water main breaks were reported  
5 from 2012 to 2017; and  
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7 WHEREAS, water main breaks have caused road and lane  
8 closures that result in traffic congestion; and  
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10 WHEREAS, traffic mitigation efforts to alleviate the flow  
11 of traffic are often not done properly and interrupt daily  
12 commutes; and  
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14 WHEREAS, water main breaks will continue to occur and cause  
15 future traffic mitigation efforts to disrupt commutes; now,  
16 therefore,  
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18 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth  
19 Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the  
20 House of Representatives concurring, that the Office of the City  
21 Auditor is requested to conduct a performance audit of the Board  
22 of Water Supply's maintenance program and traffic mitigation  
23 measures; and  
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25 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Water Supply is  
26 requested to cooperate with the audit; and  
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
28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Auditor is requested
