SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

URGING THE AGRIBUSINESS DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION TO START A FARM APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, activities on Agribusiness Development Corporation lands must meet the current standards for agriculture and food safety best practices; and

WHEREAS, farmers vary greatly in terms of fiscal resources, farming experience, business acumen, and English language skills; and

WHEREAS, the Agribusiness Development Corporation lacks the resources necessary for constant oversight and vigilance to manage a diverse population of farmers; and

WHEREAS, farmers may not be aware that compliance is required with federal programs that ensure public health on Agribusiness Development Corporation lands, including:

- (1) United States Department of Agriculture Good
 Agricultural Practices and Good Handling Practices;
- (2) United States Food and Drug Administration's Food Safety Modernization Act;
- (3) Migrant and Seasonal Agricultural Worker Protection Act; and
- (4) United States Environmental Protection Agency's Agricultural Worker Protection Standard; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth Legislature of the State of Hawaii, Regular Session of 2018, the House of Representatives concurring, that the Agribusiness Development Corporation is urged to establish a farm

apprenticeship program that creates an efficient and effective framework or model to manage farming operations through a sublease structure in which a lead farmer is responsible for the actions of the farmer's lessees; and
