SENATE RESOLUTION

URGING THE UNITED STATES FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION TO
EXPEDITE THE APPROVAL OF NEW NONPRESCRIPTION SUNSCREEN
ACTIVE INGREDIENTS FOR USE IN THE UNITED STATES.

1 WHEREAS, currently there is a limited number of approved
2 nonprescription sunscreen active ingredients in the United
3 States; and
4

5 WHEREAS, there are pending Time and Extent Applications
6 filed by the sunscreen industry that seek approval by the United
7 States Food and Drug Administration of use of nonprescription
8 sunscreen active ingredients that are and have been used
9 globally; and

11 WHEREAS, as of the date of introduction of this measure,
12 the United States Food and Drug Administration has not approved
13 any of the applications submitted for nonprescription sunscreen
14 active ingredients, despite the demonstrated safe and effective
15 global use of these ingredients; and

17 WHEREAS, this delay in approval has hampered the ability of
18 the sunscreen industry to innovate and bring alternative
19 ingredients to the United States market; now, therefore,

21 BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate of the Twenty-ninth
22 Legislature of the State of Hawai'i, Regular Session of 2018,
23 that the United States Food and Drug Administration is urged to
24 expedite the approval of new nonprescription sunscreen active
25 ingredients and to work collaboratively with all relevant
26 stakeholders to achieve approval of ingredients that provide
27 consumers with more access and choice in sunscreen products
28 while providing the sunscreen industry with the ability to
29 innovate; and

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that certified copies of this
32 Resolution be transmitted to the United States Commissioner of
33 Food and Drugs, Majority Leader of the United States Senate,
34 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, members
35 of Hawai'i's congressional delegation, and each of the presiding
