RE: H.B. No. 1623 H.D. 1

Sir:

Your Committee on Economic Development & Business, to which was referred H.B. No. 1623 entitled:

"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO FRANCHISE INVESTMENT LAW," begs leave to report as follows:

The purpose of this measure is to clarify consumer confusion and misunderstanding with regard to national advertising campaigns by:

- Requiring an in-state franchisee to disclose at its entrance or storefront that it is not participating in a specific promotion or discount offered by a nationwide franchise; and
- Prohibiting a franchisor from limiting or placing conditions on a franchisee making the required disclosure.

AARP Hawaii testified in support of this measure. Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs provided comments.

Your Committee notes that Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs raised concerns that the disclosure requirements contained in this measure might not have been placed in the most appropriate chapter of the Hawaii Revised Statutes. Your Committee was

informed by the Department that discussions to resolve this question are ongoing. Your Committee notes that any ultimate resolution must remain within the bounds of the subject matter expressed in this measure's title. Accordingly, your Committee respectfully requests that the Committee on Consumer Protection and Commerce consider these concerns further should it decide to continue deliberations on this measure.

Your Committee has amended this measure by changing its effective date to July 1, 2112, to facilitate further discussion.

As affirmed by the record of votes of the members of your Committee on Economic Development & Business that is attached to this report, your Committee is in accord with the intent and purpose of H.B. No. 1623, as amended herein, and recommends that it pass Second Reading in the form attached hereto as H.B. No. 1623, H.D. 1, and be referred to your Committee on Consumer Protection & Commerce.
