"A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO SENIOR CITIZENS,"

The purpose of this measure is to establish a temporary fiveyear Senior Citizen Higher Education Access Pilot Program at the University of Hawaii systemwide which allows senior citizens to attend college classes:

- (1) Free of charge for no academic credit; and
- (2) At reduced tuition rates if they earn academic credit for those classes.

AARP Hawaii, Oahu County Committee on Legislative Priorities of the Democratic Party of Hawaii, Filipina Advocacy Network, and several concerned individuals supported this measure. The University of Hawaii provided comments.
